On April 16, 2011 at approximately 1212 hrs officers of the Elyria Police Department responded to 187 Gull Dr, Elyria Ohio.

Officers are investigating the death of Virgil McCoy, age 63, of that address and the death of his wife Margaret McCoy, age 65, also of that address. Both appear to have suffered gunshot wounds.

A family member had spoken with the McCoy's at approximately 1800 hrs on April 15, 2011. Police were then notified at 1212 hrs, April 16, 2011, after the McCoy's were found deceased by a family member.

A revolver, believed to have been the weapon involved, was seized as well as three other firearms which were located throughout the residence. The revolver contained a single discharged casing. A second discharged casing was located in a trash can inside the residence indicating the weapon was reloaded then, fired a second time.

The scene was processed. Evidence, including gunshot residue tests, was collected for forensic analysis. The deceased were removed from the scene by the Lorain County Coroner's Office. There were no signs of forced entry or a struggle within the residence.

The investigation into this incident is continuing at this time.
